

The 1/24/72 edition of the daily English language newspaper "The News," published at Mexico City carried an article concerning Dr. IVAN ILLICH who heads CIDOC. The article stated that ILLICH had been invited by Prime Minister PIERRE ELLIOTT TRUDEAU to participate in a conference to revise Canadian legislation. ILLICH was described in the article as the controversial ex-monsignor who resigned his monsignorship in 1968 because of what he considered to be an "inquisitional questioning by the Vatican" although he did not leave the Catholic Church. ILLICH was described as having changed procedures at CIDOC so that teachers were not paid a salary but had to find and assemble their own students and collect tuition from them. (u)

A recording of the message entitled "Let Freedom Ring" was obtained on April 6, 1971, by dialing St. Petersburg, Florida, telephone number 896-1373.

Pierre Elliott Trudeau,
"Let freedom ring! Not even Canadians, much less Americans, know of the blatant communist record of Pierre Trudeau, the Prime Minister of Canada. The news media has been very careful to keep the amazing facts about Trudeau's Red record from the people on both sides of the border. Trudeau always seems to be on hand when the communists are consolidating their powers, no matter how far away the country may be. He was in Ghana when the communists took over. He was in Algeria when Ben Bella turned that helpless nation into a communist dictatorship. Although it sounds insane, Pierre Trudeau was once picked up by our Coast Guard for paddling a canoe to Communist Cuba from Key West. Trudeau got his first government job with the help of communist Robert Brice. Brice, according to a Soviet defector, was a close friend of Soviet agent Alger Hiss. The communists held a National Economical Conference in Moscow in 1952. The Canadian delegation was organized and financed by the Canadian Communist Party. 



Enclosed for Legat, Ottawa, are two copies of an article entitled "Chinese in Canada Warn Trudeau Against Peiping Tie" which appeared in the 8/18/68 issue of "Free China Weekly," which is published by the China Publishing Company, P.O. Box 337, Taipei, Republic of China. The article concerns a resolution adopted by a three day national convention at Toronto of 22 delegates representing 12 Chinese communities and presented in letter form to Canadian Prime Minister Pierre Elliot Trudeau on 8/13/68.

The letter sets forth an appeal to Prime Minister Trudeau not to follow up on his announced intention to extend diplomatic recognition to Communist China. It describes the danger of subversion of the Chinese communities as being inherent in such recognition and states that a Chinese Embassy in Ottawa would become the field headquarters and commanding posts to direct the guerrilla warfare in North America.

Chinese in Canada Warn Trudeau Against Peiping Tie

Canadians of Chinese ancestry have appealed to Prime Minister Pierre Elliot Trudeau not to seek diplomatic ties with the Communist regime in Peiping.

The appeal was contained in a letter addressed to the Canadian Prime Minister and delivered through External Affairs Minister Mitchell Sharp at Ottawa on Aug. 13.

It was adopted as a resolution during the three-day national convention at Toronto of 22 delegates representing 12 Chinese community centers in Canada.

Trudeau's announced intention to recognize the Chinese Communist regime is "detriment-

al to the cause of peace" and amounts to "abandonment of the government of the Republic of China", the letter says.

It warns that Canadian recognition of the Mao, Tse-tung regime would lead to a "flood" of Communist agents in Canada.

Red Infiltration

The lengthy letter was read to Sharp by Y.C. Ma of Winnipeg when a 21-member delegation from the convention called on the external affairs minister to make the delivery. Sharp was acting Prime Minister at the time.

"Even now, Chinese Communist agents are known to have

infiltrated in North American communities to pave the ground for this stage of the Communist strategy," Ma said.

He added that the Chinese communities in Canada, "which have always been law-abiding and loyal to Canada, would be the first to be infiltrated, divided, and subverted."

In the letter, the delegates said Canada is either their country of birth or their adopted country, and it is in the interest of Canada and of the Chinese communities there that its government should refrain from recognizing Peiping.

"A Chinese Communist embas-

sy in Ottawa would become the field headquarters and commanding post to direct the guerrilla warfare in North America," the letter continues.

Mainland Situation

Canadian recognition of Communist China, it adds, "would obviously be detrimental to the cause of peace in general and to the peace and security of countries in Asia and the Pacific in particular."

The letter says the Chinese community in Canada knows "for certain" that the majority of the Chinese people are opposed to the Communist regime on the

mainland.

"From our information, we know that the stage is being reached when the Chinese people will no longer tolerate the ever-worsening situation, but will rise up to overthrow the Communist regime.

"For Canada to grant diplomatic recognition to the Communist regime in these circumstances would be acting against the Chinese people and giving support to the regime which they oppose."

The letter goes on to reaffirm the Chinese-Canadians' support

for the Republic of China's government in Taipei.

The government of President Chiang Kai-shek in Taiwan, it says, is the best government China has had in the last hundred years. It has become the center of attraction and hope for a brighter future for the Chinese people on the mainland as well as elsewhere in the world.

Canadian diplomatic recognition of the Chinese Communist government would therefore mean abandonment of the Chinese government supported by the Chinese people, the letter says.

In addition to the letter of appeal, the Toronto convention also gave birth to a Federation of Chinese Community Centers in Canada.

Lam Fong of Vancouver was elected first president of the federation. Vancouver, with the largest Chinese community in Canada, was chosen as the site for the federation's headquarters.

Delegates to the convention came from Vancouver, Regina, Winnipeg, Sudbury, Toronto, Hamilton, Montreal, Quebec, Ottawa, Peterborough, Calgary and Timmins.

THE CANADIAN CASTRO

To the north the United States is bounded by Canada, still nominally a part of the British Empire (such as it is) but having stealthily moved further and further away from the mother country during the tenure of Lester Pearson as Prime Minister. From Canada is exported subversion and sabotage into its friendly neighbor on the continent of North America. Into Canada are welcomed the hordes of young American draft dodgers who refuse to fight for their country. Canada has been for many years a route through which illegal and undesirable aliens enter this country. East Europeans and other Communists have infiltrated into the United States across our northern border. It was to Canada that the accused killer of Martin Luther King fled and was safely sheltered and finally spirited away. The Canadian deal to supply wheat to Communist China was a shocker at the time but now Americans are becoming inured to tales of trading with the enemy. Lester Pearson has been called by some the Kerensky of the Canadian Marxist Revolution with the new Prime Minister, Pierre-Elliott Trudeau now in a position to consolidate it.

While the Communist puppet in Cuba came to power by armed force (with the help of the United States Government and the N.Y. TIMES), Trudeau, the potential Castro of Canada, has come to power by a political maneuver. The American public watched the Castro take-over but it was fooled into believing he was anti-Communist and the "saviour of the Cuban people," as were the Cuban people themselves. Similarly Americans have watched Trudeau move into the position of Prime Minister of Canada but they are not informed concerning his background by the news media. Only those concerned about Communism and the continued spreading of its evil influence around the world are aware of the danger that the accession to power of Pierre-Elliott Trudeau poses to the United States and ultimately the whole world.

Although admittedly a radical socialist, Trudeau went into the Liberal Party which was in power in 1965 and used it as his vehicle through which to enter politics. He was promptly made a special protege of

Lester Pearson when Prime Minister, and was made his Parliamentary Secretary and then Minister of Justice. He would seem to be the hand-picked successor to the aging Pearson, ready, willing and able to carry on the leftward trend started by Pearson. Trudeau is a millionaire, a graduate of Harvard University and the London School of Economics.

Among the questionable activities in Trudeau's background are the following:

He attended a Communist-sponsored economic conference in Moscow in 1952 and on his return wrote pro-Soviet articles.

He was barred entry to the United States after attending this conference, although he has admitted that this did not keep him out of the U.S. as it is so easy to slip over the border.

He founded the magazine, CITE LIBRE, a radical socialist publication which published articles by known Communists.

He has travelled twice to China, has been personally received by Mao and has written a book glorifying Mao. One of his visits was in 1960 to celebrate the tenth anniversary of the Chinese Communist Regime.

During the Bay of Pigs invasion in Cuba he tried to row a boat from the Florida Keys to Cuba, but was detained by the U.S. Coast Guard on suspicion of spying.

He travelled across the border of Cambodia and Vietnam at the height of the Indochinese War. He was arrested crossing the India-Pakistan line.

One of the subversive organizations operating in Canada at the present time is the Canadian Peace Research Institute (CAPRI) which numbers among its staunch supporters Prof. Raymond Boyer, a convicted Soviet spy (now released after having served his sentence) and Prime Minister Trudeau. Trudeau had been a professor like Boyer, with whom he is friendly, and was credited with being the force behind the pro-Castro sentiment at Montreal University, many of whose students go to Cuba on their summer vacation. After trying to form a political bloc by uniting all the leftist elements in Quebec, Trudeau

finally joined the party in power in 1965 and worked his way to the top through it.

The man who was responsible for the exposure of Raymond Boyer as a Soviet spy with his resulting arrest and conviction has also warned of Trudeau. In a memorandum prepared shortly before Trudeau came to power, Igor Gouzenko, Soviet defector who exposed a huge Canadian spy ring in which Americans were also involved wrote:

"Because Canadian and U.S. press, radio and television largely ignored the past activities and writings of Trudeau, the public is not aware of a real possibility that on the 8th of April, 1968, the next Prime Minister of Canada might be a self-admitted radical socialist and Canada might with ever increasing pace turn into a second Cuba...."

"The present Minister of Justice, Pierre-Elliott Trudeau, was elected to Parliament only in 1965.....He is careful not to call himself a communist, but as a matter of record, he was once barred from the United States as a communist....."

"Yet in spite of this background, shortly after Trudeau was elected to Parliament in 1965, Prime Minister Pearson appointed him his Parliamentary Secretary, and then made him, of all things, the Minister of Justice.

"Pearson now supports Trudeau in the leadership race.....Press, radio and television are giving Trudeau unprecedented publicity, building him up as an intellectual....."

"Pearson's own background is well-known. Elizabeth Bentley testified under oath that Pearson was giving the Soviet spy ring information...."

Gouzenko, a young attache of the Russian Embassy in Ottawa, Canada, defected in 1945 and revealed the existence of a big Soviet espionage ring, operating not only in Canada but in the United States. The (now defunct) left-wing New York newspaper PM carried a word of warning to the comrades on February 19, 1946 under the headline: "FBI WATCHING 100 ATOM SPY SUSPECTS IN U.S.A." The article stated:

"President Truman has received a secret report from the FBI (Federal Bureau of Investigation) which lists names of more than 100 men and women in this country who directly or indirectly have cooperated with a foreign spy ring attempting to 'crack' the secrets of atomic energy here and in Canada.

"It was learned that the FBI has had this organization under surveillance for almost a year and can begin making arrests at any moment that the White House authorizes action. (And you know it never did Ed.)

"The espionage organization, it was said by informed officials, was activated by agents of Soviet

Russia.

"The espionage activities inside the U.S.A., it was indicated, dwarf those carried on in Canada. Spy activities in Canada resulted last week in a special statement by Prime Minister W.L. MacKenzie King, a sweeping series of arrests....."

"Activities of the ring, it was understood, have precipitated a highly embarrassing situation at the White House and State Dept. President Truman and Secretary of State Byrnes are said to be none too anxious to order arrests....."

An official 1945 security memorandum explains the background of all this espionage activity:

"During the period since V-E Day, and particularly since V-J Day, the picture of Soviet espionage activity in the United States has become clearer.

"According to the information furnished to a representative of this Bureau and to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police by Igor Gouzenko, as set out elsewhere in this memorandum, the headquarters of Red Army Intelligence in Moscow issued instructions after the use of the atomic bomb in Hiroshima and on Nagasaki, and in fact subsequent to the actual surrender of Japan, that the discovery of all technical phases of the construction of the atomic bomb was the number one espionage project for the Soviets.....According to Gouzenko, the complete data was to be supplied to Moscow regarding the atomic bomb by the end of December 1945....."

"With regard to espionage in the United States, Igor Gouzenko, former code clerk in the office of the Soviet military attache, Ottawa, Canada, advised a representative of this Bureau and officers of the RCMP, that during World War II the head of Red army intelligence activities in the United States was Gen. Illya Saraev (Saraev) the military attache. Two of the principal operators of espionage rings under Saraev (Saraev) were Pavel P. Mikhailov, acting Soviet consul general in New York City, and Col. A.I. Sorvin (Servin) of the tank department of the Soviet Government Purchasing Commission....."

"During the United Nations Conference on International Organization, held at San Francisco in the spring of 1945, Louise Bransten entertained at her home Dimitri Manuilski, the principal representative of the Ukraine S.S.R., who is more widely known as a longtime official and spokesman of the Comintern. Bransten is, at the present time, in New York City where she has established contact with Pavel Mikhailov, acting Soviet consul general, who has been reported to this Bureau and to the RCMP by Igor Gouzenko, mentioned elsewhere in this memorandum, as the head of Red army intelligence activity in the New York area." (When questioned about this information by a Senate Committee, Louise Bransten

took the Fifth Amendment. She may be remembered as a friend of N.Y. Sen. Jacob Javits, one whom he has stated that it was suggested that he marry.)

At the time of the formation of the U.N. in San Francisco, Sen. Javits visited Louise Bransten in her home. During this same trip, Javits also had conversations (observed by the FBI) with top U.S. Communist, millionaire Frederick Vanderbilt Field. Raymond Boyer, mentioned previously as a Soviet spy convicted in Canada, is also a millionaire Communist and his wife, Madaleine, is the former Mrs. Frederick Vanderbilt Field. Field, now living in Mexico, is married to Boyer's first wife.

At the time of the formation of the U.N. in San Francisco, former Canadian Prime Minister Lester Pearson was there as senior adviser to the Canadian delegation to the conference. He played an important part in helping to formulate the United Nations Charter and was considered a possibility for the post of the first Secretary General of the U.N. He was a member of the Canadian delegation to the U.N. from 1946 to 1957 and chairman of that delegation from 1948 through 1956.

Lester Bowles Pearson came to the United States in June 1942 as Minister-counselor at the Canadian Legation in Washington, D.C. He helped establish the United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Administration (UNRRA) in November 1943 and represented Canada at the Dumbarton Oaks conference which was held from August to October 1944 to draw up preliminary plans for the establishment of the United Nations. In January 1945 he became Canadian Ambassador to the United States. While in Washington Pearson was friendly with a number of key individuals connected with the subversive Institute of Pacific Relations. An exhibit in the Senate Hearings on the I.P.R. shows that Pearson attended a private IPR discussion group on United Nations cooperation on March 15, 1943 at which the following persons were present: Ralph Bunche of O.S.S.; Edward C. Carter of I.P.R.; Dr. Frank Coe, Board of Economic Warfare; Michael Greenberg, Board of Economic Warfare; W.L. Holland, I.P.R.; David Weintraub, Office of Foreign Relief and Rehabilitation; Len DeCaux, publicity director of the C.I.O., Washington, D.C. All of these have a record of varying degrees of connections with the International Communist Conspiracy, ranging from Communist-front affiliation to Communist Party membership to Soviet espionage.

While in the U.N. Pearson delivered what has been termed "one of the most critical speeches of American policy ever made by a Canadian statesman." He opposed a United States plea that Communist China be declared an aggressor in the Korean

war and suggested a milder resolution which was adopted. He headed the General Assembly's Political and Security Committee during the special session that paved the way for the establishment of the state of Israel. When the U.S. Government requested permission for the Senate Internal Security Subcommittee to interview Igor Gouzenko, the Soviet defector, Pearson did all in his power to block this permission. Gouzenko prepared a statement dated November 20, 1953 in which he said:

"I believe a meeting would be useful since I can give advice which, if properly put into effect, I have good chances of bringing exposure of present Soviet spy rings in the United States in comparatively short time....."

"It appears that Mr. Pearson was ill advised and acted in such haste that he even neglected to read the original interview upon which he based his not correct statement in Parliament."

As Prime Minister for External Affairs, Lester Pearson bitterly attacked the U.S. Senate Internal Security Sub-committee for having exposed his close friend, Dr. Herbert Norman, as a Communist. Norman was made Canadian Ambassador to Cairo and conveniently "committed suicide" there early in 1957.

On April 22, 1963 Pearson was sworn in as fourteenth Prime Minister of Canada. He began campaigning for a new flag to replace Canada's traditional Red Ensign and, in spite of much opposition, managed to force through a bill authorizing a new flag. On November 20, 1967 Pearson gave a five thousand dollar award to Robert Bryce in recognition of his "outstanding service." Robert Bryce, Canada's deputy Minister of Finance, shortly thereafter ordered the cancellation of the International Service of the CBC - programs over six channels beamed to the people behind the Iron Curtain. Robert Bryce was known to belong to a communist study group in Washington, D.C., where he served. He was a close friend of Alger Hiss and in fact has been called the Canadian Alger Hiss.

The Senate Internal Security Sub-committee heard testimony from a prominent Japanese Communist student leader, Shigeto Tsuru, on March 26, 1957 that there was a close association between Herbert Norman (the Cairo "suicide") and Robert Bryce at Harvard University. (SCOPE OF SOVIET ACTIVITIES IN THE USA, pp. 5021-5022)

Recently Mr. Pearson was presented with a scroll of appreciation by the president of the Ontario Liberal Federation "in appreciation for the outstanding work done during the prime minister's term of office." When asked what he considered the most

outstanding piece of legislation he accomplished, Pearson replied: the removal of the Red Ensign, Canada's national flag. Other "accomplishments" were the removal of the royal insignia from mail boxes; removal of royal insignia from armed forces' cap badges; the subtle introduction of new stamps not bearing the Queen's head, substituting fishes and birds, etc. Pearson pushed a bill through for "unification" of Canada's armed forces. Commenting on the bill, Peter Trueman, President of the Canadian U.N. Association, stated: "If the stated objectives of unification of its armed forces are achieved, (Canada) will be the only country in the world whose army will fit U.N. peace-keeping force requirements." Pearson has gone on record, stating in an article published in MACLEAN's MAGAZINE of May 2, 1964 that certain members of the United Nations, including Canada are strongly in favor of building a "permanent organization for international peace-and-police action," and suggesting that this might be accomplished "by organizing a force for this purpose, one formally outside the United Nations but ready to be used at its request." This seems to be what he proceeded to do in Canada. America will be pleased to know that while Cuba points atomic weapons in our direction, Canada has a ready-made U.N. "peace-keeping" force ready to move across the border.

Pearson has now turned the reins over to his successor, Trudeau, who may be expected to continue the stealthy leftward steering of the top half of the continent of North America. Under Trudeau, Canada had an unprecedented mail strike. One of Trudeau's first acts was to call for the recognition of Communist China. Under Trudeau draft dodgers and military deserters from the United States find life good. According to the U.S. NEWS AND WORLD REPORT of October 28, 1968 estimates of the number of draft dodgers in Canada vary from as low as 300 to 400 to as high as 25,000. The article states:

"Here (Ottawa) as in nearly every other major city in Canada there are organizations—such as Ottawa's Assistance with Immigration and the Draft—that help young Americans coming to this country.

"Groups like AID counsel the new arrivals on how to file for residence papers, where to find jobs, how to obtain low-cost accommodations. Those who come to this country without funds often receive free room and board temporarily."

Trudeau, the radical, may be expected to continue the policy of Pearson who permitted Toronto to become the key distribution point in North America for THE CRUSADER, the revolutionary periodical published in Peking by Communist Robert Williams, who fled from the United States to Communist Cuba with charges of kidnapping hanging over

his head. This publication is reportedly smuggled into the United States through Mrs. Anne Olson, 21 Ellis Gardens, Toronto, wife of Verne Olson, former National Chairman of the Communist Fair Play for Cuba Committee, a group to which Lee Harvey Oswald belonged. Verne Olson was a key technician in the Electrical Research Division of the Ontario Hydro Power Commission, which operates the Sir Adam Beck Niagara Station No. 2—source of the November 9, 1965 blackout of northeastern United States. (See our issue on Rehearsal for Revolution.)

U.S. Law Enforcement Agencies have intercepted a copy of a 12-page Communist blueprint for nationwide destruction by sabotage of America's Selective Service offices, which was prepared in Toronto, Canada. This document contained detailed instructions for making Molotov cocktails, time bombs, etc. The CRUSADER regularly presents plans for Communist sabotage in the United States. Red guerrilla patrols have also been moving back and forth across the U.S.-Mexico border and jamming devices have been set up in Mexico to jam radio frequencies used by the police and border patrol. Subversion is to the north and to the south of us, as well as NINETY MILES offshore.

Canada seems to be considered by the State Department a good place to send pro-Communist or compromised foreign service officers. Wilbur Proteus Chase, in charge of the Consular Section of the U.S. Embassy in Ottawa, is strongly and openly pro-Communist as are other members of his family. Daroslav S. Vlahovich, after being compromised by female Communist Secret Police agents in Warsaw, was sent to the U.S. Embassy in Toronto where he was in charge of visas.

A warning about Canada has been sounded by that staunchly pro-American congressman, Hon. John R. Rarick, who stated on the floor of the House of Representatives on October 12, 1968:

"With terrorist activity on the increase in Mexico and other Latin American countries—Americans should expect Canada to be infiltrated as a base of anti-American activity. Prime Minister Pierre Elliott Trudeau leaves much to be desired...." Rarick termed Trudeau "A Potential Castro in Canada."

The CBC stands accused in the Commons of "pandering to separatists" and of "inciting to riot" here at home while "encouraging revolutionaries" abroad.

Prime Minister Trudeau has promised to investigate. The charge against the CBC of "leading the French network of separatist propaganda" was filed by Creditiste Leader Caspey.

The other two accusations came from former Conservative prime minister John Diefenbaker. Mr. Caspey was repeating an earlier charge of CBC aid and comfort for separatism, but Wednesday he went a step further, rejecting the prime minister's previous undertaking that the network would be asked for an explanation, demanding instead an "independent investigation."

He had done so, he explained later, because there had been previous government promises to demand an accounting from the CBC, and nothing has come of them, nothing has changed.

It was meaningless, he protested, that the CBC should be asked to investigate itself.

The prime minister assured him the proposal for an independent inquiry would be studied.

Last fall when the same issue arose, the prime minister, promising to "look into it," said he would "not hesitate to slash" the CBC parliamentary grant, currently costing \$191,000,000, should the charges be substantiated.

Responding to Mr. Diefenbaker's complaints about the CBC, the prime minister pledged "all diligence" in investigating "these very serious charges."

Mr. Diefenbaker protested what he called "a very great increase" of some CBC broadcasts, calculated to "win a million votes here, after the fashion of those in the United States."

In the lobby of the Commons a few moments later he accused "some CBC broadcasters" of spending public money to "glorify violence, worship revolution and undermine law and order."

"These broadcasters," he went on, "preach the gospel that wrong is right, that decency is dirty, that observing the law of the land is lunacy."

His second bill of complaint against the CBC was its "years of recent broadcasts that a Toronto-based organization to help American draft dodgers and deserters has penetrated RCMP headquarters."

The CBC, explained Mr. Diefenbaker, had reported that RCMP security and intelligence agents had leaked "confidential information" to the anti-draft organization.

This "secret" information, which he branded as "utterly untrue," was that the RCMP "tip-off service" on U.S. draft dodgers and deserters.

The way the CBC told it related Mr. Diefenbaker, was that the FBI alerted the RCMP to these fugitives, so they could be "yellow tagged and harassed."

This too, the prime minister promised, would be investigated.

At RCMP headquarters one of a teletype tip-off service was denied.

There would be no point in explaining the RCMP, he explained, the RCMP's supposed service would have no purpose. Even if the RCMP knows that newly-arrived Young Americans is a draft dodger or deserter, there is nothing they can do about it.

"Will the prime minister," he asked, "please inform the CBC that Canada is not in a state of active war with the United States?" Mr. Trudeau nodded, apparently in the affirmative. In the Commons corridors a moment later, in the hearing of several New Democratic members, Mr. Nesbitt wondered "which is the most rabidly anti-American, the CBC, the NDP or the Viet Cong?"

over the CBC that place before the Canadian people subversion, a foreign ideology and a general attitude of having Canadians aroused to an appreciation of these things that are foreign to our system of government and to our philosophy," Mr. Diefenbaker declared.

He said that "Action Set" was one of the programs which he had in mind.

The ex-Conservative leader said he had been advised that the CBC had received many complaints from the public about this program.

"It was simply the doctrine of Communism and subversion and one thing I particularly objected to was a professor, an American, who

stated that they had information from RCMP headquarters to the effect that there was co-operation as to the RCMP and FBI to harass these immigrants coming to Canada who are draft dodgers and worse."

Mr. Diefenbaker said he was also concerned about the possibility that the "very serious" unrest at American universities since the Kent State incident might seep across the border to Canada.

"I only hope that Canadian media do not devote their time to disseminating information regarding what is going on there in a way that is enigmatic and cannot but contribute to unrest in our own country," he said.






