On 6/17/76, SA [REDACTED] of the United States Secret Service (USSS) advised that Prime Minister TRUDEAU arrived in Washington, D.C. (WDC) at 2:20 p.m. and departed at 10:07 p.m. without incident during the interval. The only deviation from the Prime Minister's planned itinerary, set out in referenced 6/15/76 communication, was that he visited the Capital Yacht Club located at 1000 Water Street, S.W., to see a Novascotian Schooner and to shake hands with its captain at 2:45 p.m. before proceeding to the Canadian Ambassador's residence.

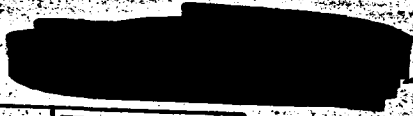

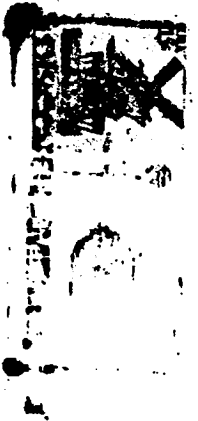

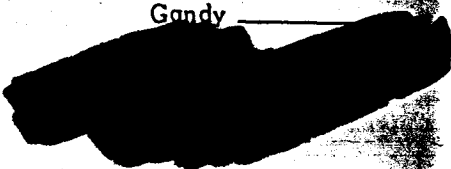

LET FREEDOM RING

A recording of the message entitled "Let Freedom Ring" was obtained on March 29, 1971, by dialing St. Petersburg, Florida, telephone number 896-1373.

"Let freedom ring! Most Americans would be shocked to be told that Pierre Trudeau, the Prime Minister of Canada, is a communist, who adores Mao Tse-tung and wants to make Canada over into a Red Chinese-style communist slave state. But there can be no doubt that Pierre Trudeau is a communist. The American press, like the Canadian press, is strangely silent about Trudeau's subversive background. Like many communist leaders, Trudeau was born a millionaire. He went to the London School of Economics, which trains young men to become good Marxists. Mr. Trudeau was in the Canadian Officers' Training Corps during World War II, but was apparently kicked out for disciplinary reasons, then joined the communist-backed Bloc-Populaire, the main function of which was to undermine the Canadian war effort. It is probably no accident that 'Bucky' Pierre was in Shanghai when Mao Tse-tung took over and started a reign of terror never before equaled in history. The man who is now the Prime Minister of Canada was there when Mao Tse-tung opened the slaughter house that eventually murdered thirty million Chinese. Apparently Comrade Trudeau approved, as he wrote, 'Mao Tse-tung is one of the greatest men of the century.' It is hard to believe that we are talking about the Prime Minister of Canada.

Although few Canadians or Americans know about Trudeau's communist background, he has done little to hide it, but he has been carefully shielded from exposure by both the Canadian and American news media. If something isn't done soon, we will have another Communist China to our north, with 4,000 miles of fully protected border. Cuba is a problem, but you haven't seen anything yet! More on Prime Minister Trudeau next week. Thank you for calling. Let freedom ring!"

The February 11, 1966, edition of "The St. Petersburg Times," a daily newspaper published in St. Petersburg, Florida, stated, "Let Freedom Ring preaches ultraconservative views through an unlisted telephone number."

The October 27, 1965, edition of "The St. Petersburg Times," indicated that the "Let Freedom Ring telephone message (was) founded by Doctor William Campbell Douglass, Sarasota (Florida)."

The Dorion inquiry, which was referred to at length in relet, made its report on 6/29/65. This report questioned Minister of Justice Favreau's judgment for taking it upon himself to decide against prosecution in connection with bribery allegations brought to his attention in September, 1964. It was pointed out that he was justified in thinking on the basis of evidence available that prosecution would have been difficult to obtain, but the investigation should have been followed up. The report said there could be no doubt that a \$20,000 bribe was offered to obstruct the course of justice in the case of narcotics smuggling suspect Lucien Rivard and that the Parliamentary Secretary to the Prime Minister had committed a reprehensible act in trying to use his influence to get Rivard out of jail on bail, although his actions were not criminal.

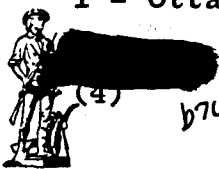
The report also said there was prima facie evidence of an offense under the Canadian Criminal Code though the investigator does not say who might have committed it. It also pointed out that an executive assistant to the Minister of Justice also was guilty of a reprehensible but not malicious conduct in intervening on behalf of bail for Rivard. Another special assistant to the Minister of Justice was charged with having acted imprudently but not reprehensibly in putting pressure on the attorney hired by the U.S. for the extradition of Rivard.

The report was also highly critical of the RCMP's investigation methods and Commissioner Mc Clellan's methods of interpreting evidence in conjunction with the Minister of Justice were also severely criticized. The RCMP's use of English-speaking investigators to question French-speaking persons was described as "most extraordinary."

Canadian officials say that Prime Minister Pierre Elliott Trudeau came to Washington for a political reappraisal with President Nixon as well as to expedite agreement on the economic differences between the two neighbor nations.

Trudeau met for two hours with Nixon yesterday afternoon and then again for several more hours at a stag dinner last night at the White House.

While the President and the prime minister were conferring—mainly in the presence of their special assistants for foreign policy, Henry W. Kissinger and Ivan Head—Cabinet-level officials of the two governments were holding a separate meeting on problems of mutual interest.

The United States was represented by Treasury Secretary John B. Connally and

Secretary of Commerce Maurice Stans while the Canadian officials were Minister of Finance Edgar J. Benson and Minister of Industry, Trade and Commerce Jean-Luc Pepin.

Announcements Unlikely

Officials of both sides indicated they doubted there would be any immediate disclosure of agreements as a result of the meetings, but both emphasized that they were held in a most cordial atmosphere.

The range of subjects covered by the two chiefs of state ranged from the Indo-Pakistan war to the Middle East, and from U.S. surcharge on imports to questions of trade imbalances, energy resources and defense spending.

The Canadians did not expand on Trudeau's desire for

political reappraisal" but said the prime minister felt the need for examining where "we are now."

Trudeau also sought the meeting with Nixon because he thought lower-level talks that have been in progress had reached the point where they would benefit from a shove at the top level, the Canadians said.

The Canadians said the prime minister put a general proposition to Nixon to find out the long-term U.S. attitude toward Canada and "received a response that was considered reassuring." They said the larger part of the Nixon-Trudeau conversation was devoted to bi-lateral economic relations.

Views Diverge

There were indications from both sides that the surcharge was high on the list of subjects

discussed, but Canadians sources said the Cabinet-level meeting demonstrated that the two points of view are considerably divergent. They said there even is a discrepancy in the figures the two nations use, the U.S. is looking for correction of an imbalance now favorable to Canada, while Canada admits the present imbalance but considers that other factors bring the trade level much closer to equal.

White House press secretary Ronald L. Ziegler, briefing reporters on the same meeting, said the major part of the talks concerned multi-lateral matters.

Ziegler said Nixon and Trudeau talked about NATO, Nixon's upcoming trip to China and Trudeau's recent discussions with Russia's Alexi Kovalev. Nixon wanted to hear

Trudeau's comments on his talks with Kosygin in Ottawa, Ziegler. Nixon said, although he revealed that the Canadian prime minister already has written Nixon about them. Canadian officials hastened to say later that it was a very short letter.

Ziegler quoted Nixon as saying he was pleased with the meeting and delighted that Trudeau could come to Washington. Nixon plans to visit Canada some time next spring, Ziegler added.

Energy at Issue

The Canadians want relief from the 10 percent U.S. import surcharge that they say is especially burdensome to Canadian industry and aggravates a severe unemployment problem. They also are concerned about the pervasiveness of U.S. investment in Canada. Trudeau also opposes

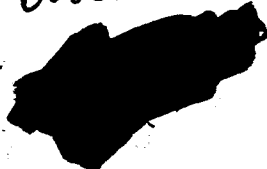
changes sought by the United States in the auto pact that permits free movement of new cars across the border to Canada's advantage.

The United States, in turn, wants increased export of energy and natural resources because of recurrent power shortage and is urging a guarantee of supplies of petroleum, gas and minerals from Canada. The Canadians are opposed to any package deal that regards its resources as continental rather than national.

The visits by Trudeau called a working visit, rather than a state visit—is the first in a series of meetings Nixon is holding over several weeks with major allied leaders in preparation for Nixon's journey's next February and May to Peking and Moscow respectively.

President Charms Trudeau, Medici

After the United States, Canada and Brazil are the two largest and most prosperous nations of the Western Hemisphere, and each has political, economic and emotional problems from living in the shadow of the giant.

But in the past 48 hours, President Nixon has charmed

Interpretation

the chiefs of state of both countries like a master pupil of Dale Carnegie.

Prime Minister Pierre Trudeau of Canada and President Emilio Medici of Brazil were highly pleased over the manner in which Nixon received them, and over the things he had to say.

Both leaders held press conferences yesterday to report on their meetings with Nixon at the White House, and both made it plain that the President had scored heavily as a good friend who has their friendship and trust in return.

Neither Easily Wooed

Trudeau and Medici are not the type to be easily wooed with White House banquets or the other trappings of summitry. A year ago, Trudeau did not hesitate to suspend Canada's constitution and put his people under martial law when Quebec nationalists appeared to threaten the nation. And Medici is a career soldier who became president by the will of the Brazilian armed forces.

Both leaders came to Washington Monday with grievances, but they went away in a happier mood.

Trudeau told reporters yesterday just before his departure that he was convinced by Nixon that the 10 percent import surcharge will be removed as soon as possible and that the United States is not trying to make Canada an American colony.

Trudeau obtained nothing here except reassurance — but

that was what he mainly had come here for, he said. Whatever Nixon told him about the array of problems, mainly economic, between the United States and Canada, Trudeau obviously went back to Ottawa sold on the idea that Nixon is a friend in whom he reposes confidence.

Medici, in his first exposure to the U.S. press since he took office in October 1969, said last night he was equally impressed by his first meeting with Nixon. Medici told reporters: "Relations have always been close between the United States and Brazil and now that we are growing, we will be closer and closer."

Medici said Nixon's remarks to him showed that the American President knows that the Brazilian government represents the will of the people. He said the talks marked the first step toward more discussions for mutual progress.

Brazil and Canada are alike in their sensitivity to U.S. power, and it was this syndrome that apparently guided Nixon in his conversations with the two.

In the main, it was more exploit of style than substance. Nixon said the right things, very likely assuring the two leaders that the surcharge will be removed soon rather than late, and giving other assurances that were not discussed publicly by any of the participants.

Topics Outlined

He discussed with them his pending trips to Peking and Moscow, he chatted with them about the Middle East, and he talked in general terms about such vital issues as the Indo-Pakistan war and the world monetary crisis.

More importantly, he met with the Brazilian and Canadian leaders before his pre-travel talks with the leaders of Britain, France, Japan and West Germany. It is apparent that this personal diplomacy and show of deference to the hemispheric neighbors pleased both.

TRUDEAU EYES RECOGNITION OF RED CHINA

OTTAWA, Ont., Aug 14
Prime Minister Pierre Trudeau said today that Canadian diplomats have been asked what the reaction of other countries would be if Canada recognized Red China.

"We have begun some fairly intensive work on this problem," he told reporters. "We have polled our posts around various parts of the world and have asked them to advise us on reactions in various countries and the way these reactions might best be met or satisfied."

No Trudeau Promise

Trudeau said that he would not promise to say publicly when Canada makes its first contacts with Peking. He said the contacts may be made "on a nonofficial basis at first in perhaps a roundabout way thru third parties."

Trudeau was elected in June with a Liberal majority in parliament, which will meet on Sept. 12. During the campaign he said that his government would want to recognize Red China if Canadians would be accepted in Peking with full diplomatic privileges.

American opposition has been given as one reason for Canada's failure to recognize Red China until now, but Trudeau said in the campaign. "You are entitled to say to a friend, 'Well, to hell with you.

Be annoyed. I am going to do what I think is right, and if you think it is wrong, all right."

Made Peking Visits

Before he entered politics as a Liberal three years ago, when he was known as a wealthy leftist bachelor lawyer in Montreal, Trudeau had made two trips to Red China, and later wrote that in 1960 he had met Mao Tse-tung, whom Trudeau described as a "superb strategist." Trudeau wrote that Canadian socialists could use the federal system in this country as a valuable tool to copy Mao's strategy of establishing socialist strongholds in

various regions of a vast country.

An anti-communist Chinese-Canadian delegation, representing Chinese communities across Canada, protested here this week that Canadian recognition of Red China would open the door to a flood of Chinese communist agents.

At a meeting with Trudeau's foreign minister, Mitchell Sharp, the 24-member delegation presented a statement which argued that "a Chinese communist embassy in Ottawa would become the field headquarters and command post of direct guerrilla warfare in North America."
